The Village of Sugar Grove Council met in Regular Session with Mayor Oatney presiding.

RC: Arter, Clark, Hart, Stiles. Heineman. Heston absent.

Also: Schosek, Springer, B Uhl, Bob First RC&D, Edwards, South, Frank Uhl, Terry Vandervoort.

On motion by Arter, 2nd Heineman minutes approved as presented and reading waived. RC: Arter, Heineman, Clark, Hart, Stiles yea,

Terry Vandervoort, Lancaster City Prosecutor discussed with Council the need for the contract with her office. She answered questions, then left meeting.

Clerk stated that her report was not accurate due to the fact that her computer has been down since middle of Feb.

Police Dept. asked for to order 15 signs. No objections.

On motion by Heineman, 2nd Clark to pay bills. RC: Heineman, Clark, Arter, Hart, Stiles yea.

Barb Uhl introduced Bob First and asked if the Village would meet with the BT/SG Planning Commission at the next Council meeting and move it to St. Joseph Hall so there would be enough room for everyone.

Bob First spoke with Council on the developments of the Planning Committee stated that he would have plans for the planned entrance way to Sugar Grove at next meeting. He left meeting.

Resolution #353-98 Contracting with M-E Engineering. given 1st reading.

Resolution #354-98 Contracting with Fairfield Co. Jail. On motion by Heineman to suspend rules, 2nd Arter. RC: Heineman, Arter, Clark, Hart, Stiles yea. On motion by Arter 2nd Stiles to pass Resolution #354-98 as emergency. RC: Arter, Stiles, Clark, Hart, Heineman yea.

Resolution #355-98 Contracting with City Prosecutor to Prosecute Cases Sent to Municipal Court for a period of 2 years effective 01/01/98. On motion by Clark to suspend rules, 2nd Arter. RC: Clark, Arter, Hart, Heineman, Stiles yea. On motion by Clark to pass as emergency, 2nd Hart. RC: Clark, Hart, Arter, Heineman, Stiles yea.

Finance Committee Report: It was recommended by Committee to give full-time employees \$150.00 clothing allowance per year, and part-time \$75.00 per year, Edwards suggested that we define part-time in the Employee Policy.

Committee recommended giving Mr. South a \$0.50 an hour raise now and \$0.50 if he passes his Water test. On motion by Arter, 2nd Stiles to approve raise. RC: Arter yea, Stiles yea, Clark no, Hart yea, Heineman yea. Motion passed 4-1.

Committee recommended increase Mayor salary by \$50.00 per month, Since the Mayor cannot receive an in-term raise that it be effective Jan. 1, 2000 and to increase the Clerk-Treas. salary to \$1,000.00 per month effective as soon as possible. Ordinance #389-98 Increasing Mayor & Clerk-Treas. Salaries given 1st reading.

Mayor stated that Village would be recipients of Tree City USA for 1997. That Arbor Day would be celebrated April 25, 1998 at 10:00 AM in the Village Park.

Hart stated his concern of speeders on Main Street.

Clark asked when the pot holes were going to be taken care of.

South stated that we needed to haul sludge from sewer plant, and that it was running at about capacity. Mr. Uhl stated that when he hooked up the sewer line at 200 4th street that the sewer line was at capacity.

Motion by Hart, 2nd Stiles meeting adjourned.
