AN ORDINANCE

Providing for the compensation and bonds of the elective officers of the village of Sugar Grove.

Whereas, the act of October 22, A. D. 1902, entitled: "An act to provide for the organization of cities and incorporated villages, and to restrict their power of taxation, assessment, borrowing money, contracting debts, and loaning their credit, so as to prevent the abuse of such powers, as required by the constitution of Ohio, and to repeal all sections of the Revised Statutes inconsistent herewith", devolved the duty upon this council to fix the compensation and bonds of the elective officers of this village, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGAR GROVE,
STATE OF OHIO:

Sec. 1. The elective executive officers of the village shall be mayor, clerk, treasurer and marshal; all of whom shall be elected at the election to be held on the first Monday in April, 1903, and every two years thereafter. Such officers shall begin their respective terms on the first Monday in May succeeding their election.

Sec. 2 The compensation of the elective executive officers of the village shall be and the same is hereby fixed and prescribed as follows, to wit:- mayor, the sum of twenty dollars per annum, and in addition thereto such fees as are provided for by section 1843 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio, and that are or may be provided for by law, but he shall pay over to the treasurer of the village monthly, all fines, license fees, and other

moneys of whatsoever character which may be collected by him for the benefit of the village; clerk, the sum of twenty-five dollars per annum; treasurer, the sum of ten dollars per annum; marshal, the fees contemplated and provided for in Section 1850 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio, and in addition thereto, the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars per annum. The members of the council shall receive no compensation. All salaries shall be payable quarterly, out of the village treasury upon the warrant of the clerk, pursuant to an appropriation by council.

Sec. 3.. Each elective officer shall, before entering upon the duties of his office, give a bond, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of his office, subject to the approval of the mayor, except the mayor's bond, which shall be subject to the approval of the council, in the sums following, to wit:- mayor, five hundred dollars; clerk, five hundred dollars; treasurer, twenty-five hundred dollars; marshal, five hundred dollars.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after fifteen days after its first legal publication.
