

**ORDINANCE NO. 456-14**

**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE PRIOR YEAR ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY LEGISLATION**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the protection of the public health and safety for residents of the of the Village of Sugar Grove that the legislative process be conducted in a manner as directed by the Ohio Revised Code; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council failed to recognize the requirement for a three-fourths majority, not a two-thirds majority, to pass legislation under suspension of the rules; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council failed to recognize the requirement for a three-fourths majority of council seats, including any vacancies; and,

**WHEREAS**, it would impose undue difficulties for the residents of the Village to reverse actions taken based on legislation adopted without the necessary majority;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Sugar Grove, State of Ohio:

**Section 1:** That the following legislation is approved retroactively to the original date of adoption:

Resolution 560-13 (08/01/13) for adoption of a corrected tax budget for CY2014  
Resolution 561-13 (09/09/13) accepting rates and amounts from the Budget Commission  
Resolution 562-13 (09/09/13) increase appropriations to pay local share of sewer project  
Resolution 564-13 (09/09/13) increase appropriations to pay for Prop & Liab insurance  
Resolution 565-13 (10/14/13) to update public records policy per ORC  
Resolution 566-13 (10/14/13) to authorize president of council as secondary signatory  
Resolution 567-13 (10/14/13) to authorize the sale of 1999 Police cruiser  
Resolution 568-13 (11/11/13) to decrease annual appropriations  
Ordinance 444-13 (10/14/13) giving consent for County Engineer to plow snow  
Ordinance 445-13 (10/14/13) to approve annual appropriations for CY2014

**Section 2:** That any action taken on behalf of the Village as a result of the original adoption is also retroactively authorized as of that date.


